

217-227 Lowerhouse Lane

217-227 Lowerhouse Lane, Burnley, Lancashire, BB12 6LP



Row of 6 cottages. c1820-30, for Dugdale's Lowerhouse mill. Watershot coursed sandstone (Nos 219 to 223 painted), stone slate roofs to Nos 217 and 219.

Welsh slate to Nos 221-227 with rendered brick chimneys. Rectangular double-depth plan, each cottage single-fronted with 2 low storeys, one window each, with a continuous square-cut gutter cornice.

Doorways to the right, all with plain surrounds and altered doors; windows with raised sills and rectangular lintels, all now with altered glazing and those at No.221 now with widened openings containing bowed glazing; ridge chimneys, left gable coated with pitch.

Part of a relatively an early industrial colony at Lowerhouse, forming a group with Nos 204-238 opposite and with Nos 2-22 Lowerhouse Fold adjoining to the right.
