2 – 16 Fox St, Lowerhouse, Burnley, Lancashire, BB12 6NE



Row of 8 cottages c1820-30, for Dugdale's of Lowerhouse Mill, positioned on very steep hill built in pairs, leading down from Lowerhouse Lane to Green Brook and Lowerhouse Lodge.

Mainly of coursed squared sandstone with slate roofs and brick chimneys mostly rendered.

Each cottage single-fronted 2 storeys, and two 1st-floor windows each with a continuous square-cut gutter cornice sloping downwards from left to right; All with vertical-rectangular windows with raised sills and run-out rectangular lintels, all with altered glazing, and recessed altered doors.

Forms group with 1 -15 Wellersley Street which is positioned parallel and immediately behind.
