312-320 Lowerhouse Lane, Burnley, Lancashire, BB12 6NB



The area includes two rows backing onto one another, with a cobbled service road between that is accessed by an archway at the north-east end; the terraces slope down to the south-west. None of the houses have front gardens, although two rows are fronted by stone-flagged pathways rather than streets accessible to vehicles.

These cottages were built in the 1820s and 1830s and in the mid-nineteenth century, immediately behind each end of this block of houses are Wellersley Street and Fox Street, that both run down the hill to towards Green Brook an Lowerhouse Lodge.
